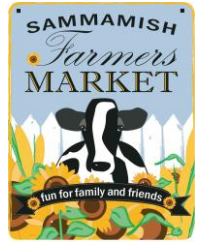


Sammamish Farmers Market 2011

ELIGIBILITY

Non-profit/community group booths will be assigned on a first come first serve basis and will be considered on a case by case basis. Organizations with a strong membership base or involvement in Sammamish and those with educational outreach related to sustainability, community and health will be prioritized.

THE BOOTH

The Market will provide a 10'x10' canopy (in some cases, with prior notice, this will be shared with another organization), two chairs (four when two groups are sharing the booth) and a 6' folding table. Participants must provide their own booth displays and off-site garbage disposal as necessary. No application or booth fees apply to the booths but full participation in set-up and breakdown is expected if able.

All non-profit/community groups must follow all rules of the Farmers Market, available at www.sammamishfarmersmarket.org Here are some important reminders:

- Non-profit/community group booths are for marketing and advertising only.
- Fundraising (such as raffle tickets, book sales) are not allowed at the market.
- Market management has full authority to assign stall space.
- The booth must be staffed at all times from 4-8pm. The market is open rain or shine.
- Set-up should be completed by 3:50pm. Please aim to arrive at the market between 3:00 and 3:30pm.
- Breakdown can only begin at 8:00pm (after September 1, breakdown may begin earlier when announced by Market Manager)
- Non-profits/community groups are responsible for keeping their stall attractive and free of trash at all times, and for removing their trash and debris at the close of business (trash should not be disposed of in market bins).
