

2026 Sammamish Farmers Market Youth Policies and Rules

Dear Youth Vendor,

We are very happy to see you have expressed interest in selling at the Sammamish Farmers Market! Read the following policies carefully before completing the application form found at www.sammamishfarmersmarket.org.

Booth space will be available during the market season for local youth (age 17 and younger) who have handmade craft products they would like to sell at the market. Due to health regulations food products may not be sold by youth vendors. Participants must provide and set up a 10X10 canopy, table and chairs to offer their product for sale. Four, 24-pound weights for canopies will be required. Youth vendors may sell no more than 3 days for the 2026 season.

Non-residents may contact manager@sammamishfarmersmarket.org for consideration.

A one time \$20 application fee and a stall fee of \$13 per day will be required to participate. Fees must be paid prior to your chosen date. Youth vendors are allowed to sell up to 3 times this season. Location: The market is located at the Sammamish Commons, a city park adjacent to the Sammamish City Hall (801 228th Ave SE, Sammamish).

Day and Time: The market season will operate at Sammamish Commons on Wednesdays from the beginning of May to the middle of Sept. The market will be open between the hours of 4 pm and 8 pm from May thru August and 4pm-7pm in September. The market may close at an earlier hour, depending on weather and lighting conditions. Please check sammamishfarmersmarket.org for season dates. Plan to arrive at the market no later than 3pm to begin set-up.

The Market will provide as much assistance as possible with marketing/questions/etc. every Wednesday.

Parking: Parking is available to all vendors at . All youth vendors must park at Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church at 22818 SE Eighth St across the street from the SFM. There is NO parking at City Hall, YMCA or the Library. Those areas are for market shoppers.

Vendor Information: All products must be hand crafted (for example: pottery, basketry, jewelry) and made in Washington State. Due to Washington State Health regulations, **youth food vendors are not allowed.**

Recycling materials is encouraged. Reselling products from another manufacturer is not allowed. The youth vendor is required to make their own products.
