

Sammamish Farmers Market 2023 Season Youth Policies and Rules

Dear Youth Vendor,

We are very happy to see you have expressed interest in selling at the Sammamish Farmers Market! Read the following policies carefully before completing the application form found at www.sammamishfarmersmarket.org.

Youth vendors are residents of Sammamish age 17 or younger. Non-residents may contact manager@sammamishfarmersmarket.org for consideration.

A stall fee of \$10 will be required to participate each week. Youth vendors are allowed to sell up to 3 times this season. Participating 4 or more times in a season, will require a [Sammamish Business License](#), so you're encouraged to keep it to three sessions.

Youth Vendor will be required to bring their own 10 x 10 pop up tent, table, chairs and weights for the tent. If you don't have the above items, you may contact the market manager for options.

An application fee of \$5 must be paid when submitting an application.

Location: The market is located at the Sammamish Commons, a city park adjacent to the Sammamish City Hall (801 228th Ave SE, Sammamish).

Day and Time: The 2023 Market Season will operate at Sammamish Commons on Wednesdays between the hours of 4 pm and 8 pm beginning May 10 and ending September 20. The market may close at an earlier hour, depending on weather and lighting conditions. Plan to arrive at the market at around 3pm to begin set-up. You must get there BEFORE 3:30pm or we will not be able to let you sell that day.

Plan on bringing someone to help you set up because the market will not provide you with any help on most days, and you must bring your own tent and materials to set up your booth, including weights (each of the four weights must be 25 lbs) to hold down your canopy or cover.

The Market will provide as much assistance as possible with marketing/questions/etc. every Wednesday.

Parking: Parking is available at Mary, Queen of Peace church with a walking path back to the Market. All youth vendors must park at Mary, Queen of Peace. Parking at City Hall should be for market shoppers.

Vendor Information: All products must be hand crafted (for example: pottery, basketry, jewelry) and made in Washington State. Due to the high cost of licensing, **youth food vendors are not allowed**. In order to comply with Washington State Health Department regulations, the cost for permits are quite high. Recycling materials are encouraged. Reselling products from another manufacturer is prohibited. The youth vendor is required to make their own products.
